

Your child can get the OFFICIAL French language diploma!

What is DELF Prim?

It is the **official French language diploma** designed for children in Primary School, from 7 to 12 years old. Issued by the French Ministry of Education and organized by Alliance Française, it certifies children's level in French.

Why taking this exam?

This diploma is designed for children to **encourage them** in their French studies. It has the same value than the adult diploma & is **valid for life**.

500 children took this exam last year, with a **99** % **pass rate**! It is the opportunity for children to:

- ✓ Demonstrate their French language skills,
- ✓ Be rewarded for their work at school,
- ✓ Get used to sitting exams for certificates from the beginning of their French studies.

What does the exam consist of?

On **Saturday 15 June**, children will have to complete two tests:

- **1.** Written part (approx. 1 hour): filling in a workbook with topics adapted to their age and divided into 4 parts: listening reading, speaking and writing skills.
- **2. Oral part**: a short conversation with a teacher, to introduce him/herself and answer a few basic questions. More info & exam samples on www.afdubai.org/delf-prim

How to register?

Give the teacher your registration file **before March 14**:

- ☐ the <u>registration form</u> attached filled in typewritten -no handwriting
- ☐ 1 photocopy of your child's passport
- ☐ AED 340 per child

The teacher will tell you which level your child is ready for: A1.1, A1 or A2. An optional preparation course will be organized on November at Alliance Française.
